Western Baptist was one of 30 community hospitals, along with 70 teaching hospitals, on the list.
- **Top 3%...100 Top Hospitals:** Thomson Reuters 100 Top Hospitals: Performance Improvement Leaders, 5th edition, examined the performance of more than 2,800 U.S. hospitals on a variety of clinical, operational and patient safety criteria to identify the 100 winners.

**Top 3%...Breast Imaging:** Of 7,569 hospitals in the U.S., only 261 have earned the American College of Radiology's Breast Imaging Center of Excellence for quality and accurate breast testing and treatment.

**Top 4%...Coronary Artery Disease Care:** The American Heart Association's Get With The Guidelines program has recognized 188 hospitals, including just three in Kentucky, for treatment of coronary artery disease.

**Top 5%...Chest Pain Treatment:** The Society of Chest Pain Centers has accredited 401 hospitals, 16 in Kentucky, for chest pain treatment.

**Top 15%...Cancer Care:** The American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer presented the Outstanding Achievement Award to 66 hospitals, only two in Kent
