Make the abstract as informative as possible. Abstract should be single-spaced, easy to read, 12 point Times New Roman font and should contain:

1. **Title:** The title should be in bold, and the first letter of each word should be capitalized. Acronyms should not be used.
2. **Authors:** Include full name of all authors. Underline the presenting author.
3. **Affiliation:** enter the affiliation (university or business authors are associated with).
4. **Abstract:** the abstract must be one concise paragraph, without subtitles, not exceeding 300 words.
5. Include the purpose of the study, methods used, results obtained and the authors discussion & conclusion based upon the results.
6. Actual data should be summarized. It is inadequate to state “results will be discussed” or “the data will be presented”.
7. Avoid tables, figures, references, credits, or grant support information.
8. Use of standard abbreviations is requested. Place a special or unusual abbreviation in parenthesis after the full word the first time it appears, and then use the abbreviation throughout remainder of the abstract.
9. All abstracts will be published in the proceedings of the conference. “Advances in Nanotechnology and Applications”, Volume 4
10. Indicate whether the abstract is for oral/poster presentation.
11. Abstracts are to be submitted via e-mail. The abstract must be in MS Word format and sent as an attachment.

The deadline for abstract submission is July 29, 2011.
