Students transferring to other Sullivan campuses must complete new applications and enter at their tuition rate.

OFFICIAL TUITION REDUCTION & ADJUSTMENT POLICY

If a student withdraws or is withdrawn from Sullivan University prior to the completion of the program, he/she will be obligated to Sullivan based on the tuition reduction policy listed in the University catalog. If a student withdraws or is withdrawn and has not paid the non-refundable percentage of tuition, the remaining unpaid balance of the percentage must still be paid as agreed. The University expects the student to complete his/her course of study. The student has one and a half times the stated credit hour length of his/her program of study to complete the required coursework.
