

Learning Outcomes for Business Programs

The Office of Institutional Research at Sullivan University compiles information about the learning outcomes for each program offered by the University. The faculty evaluate whether each program is meeting its stated outcomes annually. The results of the evaluations appear in this document for the business programs accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) and the International Assembly for Collegiate Business Education (IACBE).

Each program presents a mission statement that defines the purpose of the program. Based on the mission statement, each program presents measurable outcomes that define what students will learn in the program. Achievement of each outcome is measured by two instruments, one of which must be a direct measure of learning. Each program defines a target score for each measure. The Office of Institutional Research evaluates whether each program is meeting its target score, exceeding its target score, or falling below its target score. The results of these evaluations are presented in this document using graphical arrows.

Future Changes

In lieu of the HRL Final Project measure in HRL 471x (the BSHRL capstone course), we intend to begin using the SHRM Learning System Post-Test score, an exam taken in HRL 475x. The benchmark target will be a score of 70% or higher. The rationale for this change is that, as a university, we are collectively moving away from the use of project-related measurements. In addition, this exam is based on nationally validated test questions which we believe will be a better measure of our program's learning

outcomes going forward. This change will also make our direct measures for both the BSHRL and the MSHRL consistent resulting in more positive alignment.

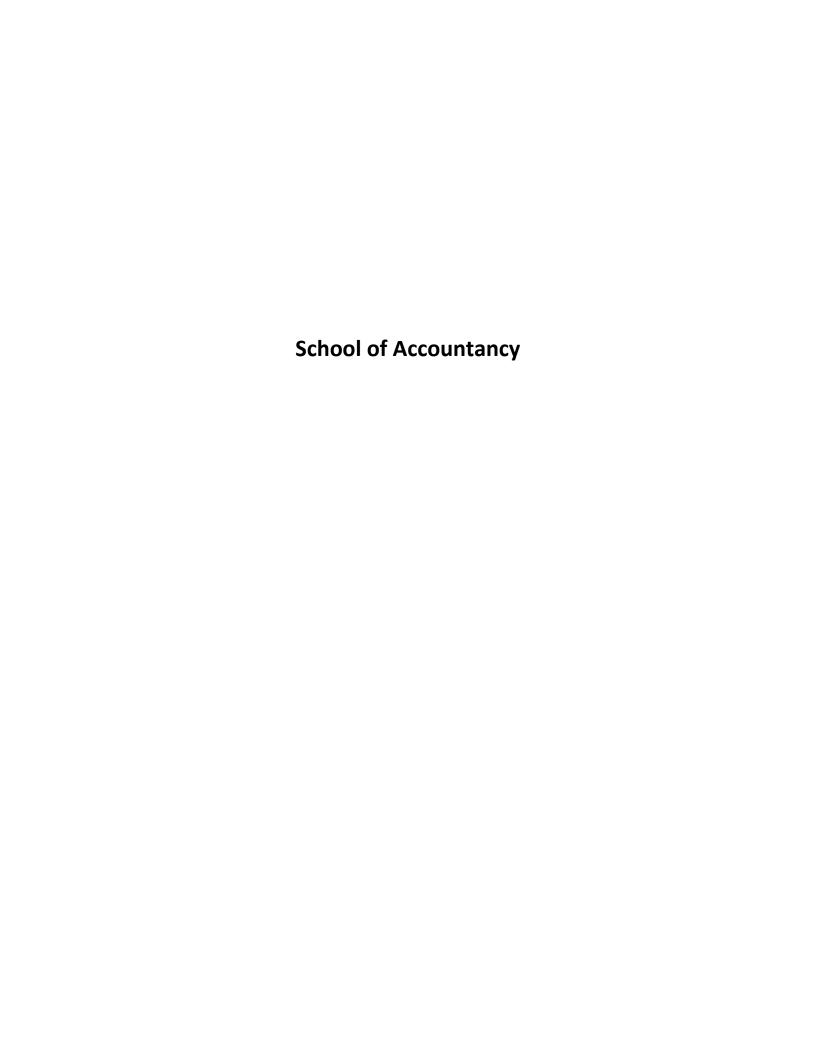
