Academic Progress

As the Office of Academic Progress it is our responsibility to help ensure every student enrolled at Sullivan University successfully completes their program(s) by:

- Monitoring all students' academic progress Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) are the minimum
 academic standards that all students at Sullivan University must achieve in order to remain enrolled,
 actively pursuing a degree and/or be able to receive Title IV monies from the Federal Government in the
 form of loans or grants.
 - These standards are measured both qualitatively by cumulative GPA and quantitatively by completion rate (credit hours attempted versus credit hours earned). Graduate School cumulative measures for GPA must remain at 3.0 or higher
- 2. Identify early signs of academic "trouble" Students failing to meet the minimum requirements for SAP will be sent notification and placed on a "Warning" status. This status will remain in effect for one quarter and then re-evaluated after the subsequent term. After serving a "Warning" quarter those students still failing to meet standards will be placed on "Suspension" and no longer allowed to attend classes until or if a successful appeal is granted.
- 3. Initiate early intervention and advising to correct issues before they escalate Notifications of Warnings, Early Alerts provided by instructors, and notification of midterm grades are ways that this office communicates with students who may be struggling at one or more point in the quarter. These notifications provide information on resources available to students of Sullivan University such as the Tutoring and Wellness Center. This also allows us to work closely with students to try to prevent academic warnings and/or suspensions.
- 4. Follow policies and procedure as outlined by The Department of Education (DOE) and the University. The DOE has specific guidelines that the university and its students have to abide by. This ensures compliance and is for the benefit of Sullivan University and our students.

We want to help ensure the successful completion of your education here at Sullivan University and have included some ways that can help you stay on the right path.
